

# ANDIE YAGHER

**Los Angeles-born singer-songwriter Andie Yagher is quickly carving out a distinctive space within contemporary acoustic pop, threading together elements of folk and country with a lyrical voice rooted in storytelling.**

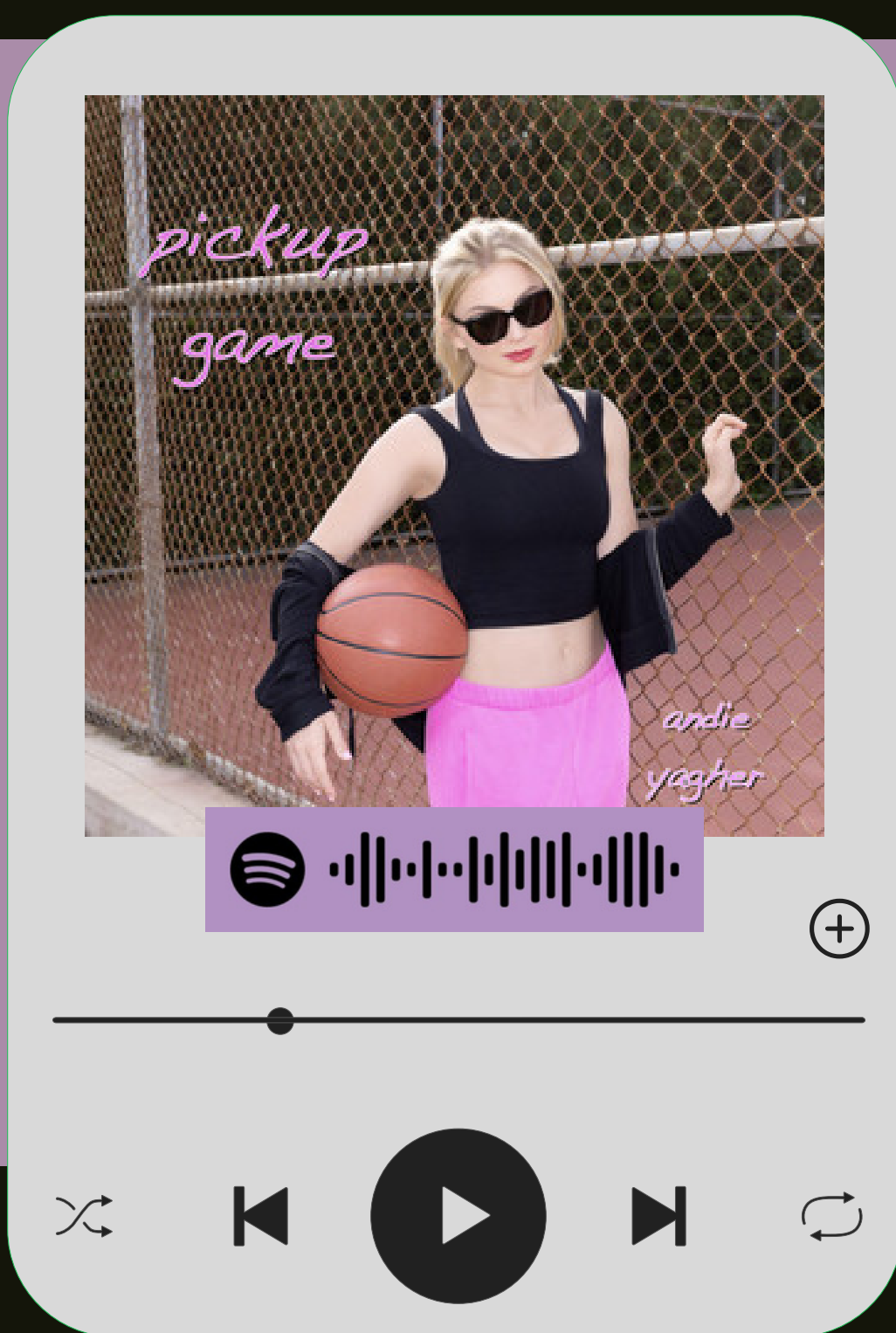
Raised in a city synonymous with entertainment, Andie's relationship with music began early—writing songs shortly after picking up the guitar and stepping onto stages while still in her youth. That instinct to perform and connect has since evolved into a refined artistic identity: one that explores heartbreak, joy, and emotional nuance through a sharply observant, poetic lens.

Beyond music, Andie's creative reach extends into theatre and film. A two-time recipient of the prestigious National YoungArts Foundation Award—winning for Dramatic Writing in 2020 and Theatre in 2021—her work as a playwright has been staged at notable platforms including the Blank Theater's National Young Playwrights Festival in Hollywood. She graduated from Sarah Lawrence College in 2024 with a Bachelor's degree in Film and Theatre, further deepening her storytelling craft across disciplines. Represented by Sovereign Talent Group, Andie continues to bridge performance and narrative across mediums.

A pivotal moment in her musical evolution came during her studies abroad at the British American Dramatic Academy (BADA) in London. Removed from the pace of Los Angeles, Andie entered an intensely creative period—writing over 30 songs in a short span, seven of which form her debut album, *Pickup Game*. The project has already gained notable traction, with placement on approximately 100 editorial Spotify playlists and thousands of user-curated playlists worldwide, plus her music being featured on IHeart Music Podcast, and *WOMEN OF SUBSTANCE*, for three of her songs; *Boxer's Tale*, *Pickup Game* and *Sweatshirt*.

Educated at Harvard-Westlake School in Los Angeles, Andie honed her musicality as a member of both the HW Jazz Ensemble and HW Jazz Singers. This foundation in jazz continues to inform her phrasing and melodic sensibility, even as her sound leans into acoustic pop and country textures. Her songwriting carries a fluidity—balancing structure with emotional spontaneity—allowing each track to feel both intimate and considered.

## ‘Pickup Game’

2026 Release

Andie Yagher's debut EP 'Pickup Game' is a concise yet emotionally layered seven-track collection that captures the immediacy of early adulthood through a stripped-back acoustic lens. Spanning just over 25 minutes, the project moves fluidly between reflective balladry and gently rhythmic folk-pop, with tracks like 'sweatshirt', 'real things', and 'twenty something' anchoring its introspective tone.

Each song feels deliberately intimate—built around guitar-led arrangements and vocal delivery that prioritises clarity and emotional nuance over excess. There's a quiet confidence in the songwriting, with narratives that explore connection, identity, and fleeting moments with a diaristic honesty. Rather than overproducing, *Pickup Game* leans into restraint, allowing space for Yagher's lyricism to lead—resulting in a debut that feels both personal and quietly assured, marking her as a compelling new voice within the acoustic pop and folk space.
